This meeting was called to order by Chairman Winkle at 9:00 a.m. and a workshop convened to hear commentary from Elected Officials and Department Heads.

The agenda as proposed was adopted, with the deletion of the Executive Session scheduled for 1:30 p.m., on motion of Commissioner Cruickshank, second by Chairman Winkle and carried.

Commenced work session with Assessor Karen Campbell, Treasurer Glenna Young, Prosecutor Matt Williams, Doug Miller, Steve Brown, and Rick Ridenour. Cynda Herrick appeared and asked to be excused as her office was without other staff available. A variety of topics were discussed, but no decisions were made.

Reconvene at 1:00 p.m.

Chairman Winkle announced the Public Hearing on the McCall Impact Area Ordinance Amendments concerning Street Banners and Micro-Livestock Amendments.

Staff report by Michelle Groenvelt who advised that these were actually McCall Amendments which may affect the impact area.

No proponents, no non-committed and no opponents concerning the Street Banner Amendment. Public Hearing closed.

Commissioner Eld moved for acceptance, second by Commissioner Cruickshank and carried.

Chairman Winkle announced Public Hearing on the McCall Impact Area Ordinance Amendments concerning Micro-Livestock.

Staff reported that the amendment is to exclude the Micro-Livestock from other requirements and allow them in residential areas. Chickens, ducks or rabbits are included, not to exceed 6 per lot and other restrictions.

No proponents, no non-committed and no opponents. Public Hearing on this issue closed.

Commissioner Eld moved for acceptance, Chairman Winkle seconded the motion and it was carried.

Session closed at 1:34 p.m. and adjourned.
