Meeting called to order by Chairman Winkle at 9:05 a.m.

Agenda for this meeting was adopted by unanimous vote, including the addition of a second topic relating to an additional personnel concern, the details of which were previously unknown.

Chairman Winkle opened the Public Hearing on the FY2011 Valley County Budget as published in the Star News. Staff report by Clerk Archie Banbury. No proponents, no uncommitted and no opponents present.

Public hearing closed at 9:17 a.m.

Commissioner Cruickshank moved to adopt the budget for FY 2011 as presented. Second by Commissioner Eld and carried by unanimous vote of the Board.

The motion to add an item to the Executive Session also concerning a second personnel issue, was approved by Roll Call Vote, Commissioner Eld, Yes, Commissioner Cruickshank, Yes, and Chairman Winkle, Yes.

Motion to convene Executive Session by Commissioner Eld, second by Commissioner Cruickshank and carried.

9:20 a.m. Convened Executive Session per Idaho Code 67-2345(b) for consideration of personnel matters, two separate topics involving two separate and unrelated employee situations.

Commissioner Winkle left the meeting and Commissioner Gordon Cruickshank, Acting Chairman is presiding.

Motion by Commissioner Cruickshank to commence Regular Session, second by Commissioner Eld and carried.

Motion by Commissioner Cruickshank, and second by Commissioner Eld to effect the requested change for the Treasurer's staffing and employ the rules established for changes in Pay Classes.

Workshop discussions with Department Heads and Elected Officials commenced and concluded without decision. The principle discussion involved the 4-10 alternative work schedule, which the vast majority of employees favored. It is difficult to measure the effect of the schedule on costs because electric rates have changed and the boiler system is also new and operates from electricity as opposed to stove oil.
