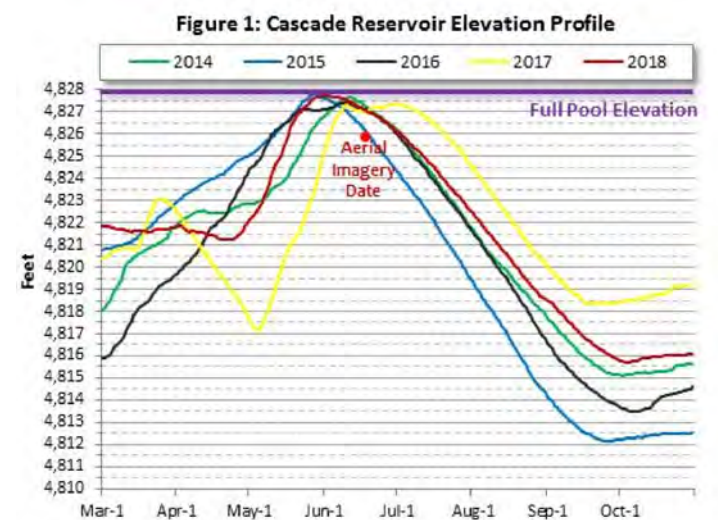


Proposed Valley County Waterways Ordinance 19-05

CASCADE RESERVOIR

Per the Bureau of Reclamation, Cascade Reservoir full-pool elevation is 4,828 feet above sea level. On the date this aerial imagery was collected in June of 2015, Cascade Reservoir was at 4,826 feet pool elevation (2' below full-pool). This level is maintained for the majority of May and June before dropping. Figure 1 illustrates the change in Cascade Reservoir Elevation between March and October for the past 5 years. A red point marks the date, year and elevation related to the map image.

This Cascade Reservoir map was created at a geographic scale of 1:78,255.
