Douglas moved to approve July 10, 2018 minutes. Barry seconded the motion.  
Motion passed.

July 31<sup>st</sup> Lt. Speer was promoted to Captain and given the chief deputy position.  
Captain Speer reported the following:

The buoy line and temporary dock has been installed in the area north of Mile High marina.

Said his understanding, the Crown Point project is to begin this fall.

VC Commissioners will hold a public hearing on proposed VC Waterways Ordinance in October. VC Clerk Douglas Miller informed Cpt. Speer of their decision. The Commissioners will review the proposed ordinance before public hearing is held.

The GIS information shows the narrowest point on Boulder Creek to be 420 feet at full pool. The Commissioners instructed No Wake buoys be placed in this area.

VC Marine account will pay for meals and lodging for two Marine Deputies while patrolling Deadwood Res.

M S Turner and the GIS person will locate hazard points on Payette and Cascade lakes. This info will be put on Sheriff Patrol map.

Review of Expenditure Activity Summary

Future expenditures: a two mile lite replacement which was damaged by boat, ice spars and new uniform items.
