Meeting Minutes

October 2, 2018

Jally moved to approve Sept. 4, 2018 minutes. Harvey seconded the motion.
Motion passed.

MS Turner reported new side scan equipment for the vessel obtained from
Clearwater County.

He said the boat exploding on Payette Lake is under investigation.

Over 2000 boat inspections and 140 students attended Idaho Boating Education
classes. Twenty seven citations were issued.

All buoys on Cascade Lake have been removed. Channel buoys will be left in the
Narrows channel area on Payette Lake. Twenty ice spars need replaced.

The Custom Weld and Thunder Jet boats will be taken out of water late October,
because there are many fishing boats still active.

Captain Speer said a lack of housing is a major factor in the hiring of summer
marine deputies.

Cpt. Speer received a letter from Don Henderson, Payette Lk. Pilgrim Cove area,
requesting a water break. Cpt. Speer said Don must go Idaho Dept. Of Lands for a
permit and he also must obtain a permit from VC Sheriff's department because a
water break is a navigation hazard.

Rich Holm's concern is the large wake a boat with ballast creates for wave surfing.
He proposed a rule to make it a misdemeanor to use these boats with ballast when
operated on waters in Valley County.

There was much discussion on wave surfing and mandatory education on Valley
County waters.
