Jally moved to approve November 6, 2018 minutes. Harvey seconded the motion.
Motion passed.

Kurt is working two IDPR grants. Adjustments for WIF grants have made it easier
to obtain them. Jally expressed concerns with a launch for motorized boats being
left out of the plans for the area north of the marina. It is not in the interest of
waterways funds being spent if motorized boats are restricted from the area.
Kurt discussed planned improvements to Browns Park.

Matt said plans for redoing the docks at Ponderosa State Park. The Easy Docks at
the park are holding up pretty good, he said.

MS Turner reported Cpt. Speer and he will be working with Matt Linde, IDPR, on
housing in Ponderosa State Park for marine deputies.
He said all boats have been winterized, so if a power outage occurs there should be
no damage to the boats.

Al announced there will be meeting with VC Commissioners on Dec. 17th to
review boating ordinance. Meeting will be held in Commissioner meeting room
from 1:00 to 4:00 P.M.

Rich Holm said since the boating industry is selling more powerful boats, it will be
hard to write an ordinance that will keep up with the advancement of boating
capabilities. He suggested writing a baseline ordinance.

Commissioner Bill Willy treated the committee with cinnamon buns.
