Meeting Minutes June 4, 2019

Harvey moved to approve May 7, 2019 minutes. Al seconded the motion. Motion passed.

MS Turner reported most of the buoys in the narrows were lost due to ice and 25 ice spars plus anchoring system. Replacement of these items will hit the budget hard. No Wake buoys will be moved to 150 feet from 300 feet from shore in accordance with Idaho code. Approximately 200 vessel stops were made for No Wake violations in 2018. He said the log removal schedule has been moved to September. He also has a Boat Idaho Class scheduled after July 4.

Dave Dahms presented the Wake Responsibility flyers that have been mailed to registered boat owners in Idaho. Water Sports Industry and IDPR sponsored this project. The flyers will be available at boat launches also.

Kurt said the grant for work north of the marina failed. Brown Park grant was approved. Al asked if paddle board launching will be moved from the boat launch. Kurt said paddle boards will be launched north of the marina.

Douglas clarified the ordinance 08-1 was not approved properly so is invalid. VC Commissioners sent the ordinance back to VC Waterways Committee for other considerations. Idaho Code Boating Regulations will be inforce.

The 2020 budget was discussed.
