Al moved to approve July 9, 2019 minutes as written. Barry seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Carol Brockmann discussed the complaints from several citizens of violation by the committee of the Open Meeting Law. The V C Waterways Advisory Committee meeting must be posted 48 hours in advance. Harvey moved the Committee acknowledge the Open Meeting Law violation. Barry seconded the motion. Discussion and the motion was passed. Jally moved to acknowledge the declared motions in July be void. Harvey seconded the motion. Discussion and the motion passed.

Harvey moved the Official Statement listed July 2, 2019 agenda under ordinance be voided. Jally seconded the motion. Discussion and the motion passed.

Al moved that the Diversion Program be used in the ordinance, where it is appropriate, under the issuance of Citations. Jally seconded the motion. Discussion: PA Brockmann explained the meaning of this program and the motion was unanimously passed.

Attendees expressed concern of age limit to operate a vessel, wake causing erosion, safe area for swimmers were just a few.

Ed Allen asked if 08-01 ordinance did not follow legal procedure, could it still be kept in force? Commissioner Bingaman said the 08-01 cannot be reinstated by commissioners as it must go through legal procedures.

Jally moved to table further discussion of the ordinance until September's meeting as an Action Item. Harvey seconded the motion. Discussion and the motion passed.

Matt Linde said the Wake Responsibly sign has been installed at Ponderosa Park boat ramp. Dock refuse will be cleaned up last of Sept. or early Oct. Jally, Keven and Matt will set date and time, He ask if the 300 foot swim line could be left in place during July 4th week on east side of north beach. Douglas said it will be an Action Item at Sept. meeting.

MS Turner said a private resident in Cascade has set up a Boat Towing service. This would help deputies from being called for nonemergency tows. He reported 600 vessel inspections were done during July 4th week. A total of 1200 inspections have been done to date. Forty one infractions and eight citations.

Al discussed the Budget, Expenditure and Income reports.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:35 A.M. Next meeting Sept. 3, 2019.
