

VALLEY COUNTY GROOMER ADVISORY COMMITTEE

December 12, 2019

Chairman Ron Platt called the meeting to order at the Emergency Operations Center in Cascade at 7:00 pm on December 12, 2019.

Present were Ron Platt, Terri Klanderud, Rob Workman, Mark Sabin, John Hicks, Larry Meredith, Mark Wood, and Vic Greenfield. Also present was Kevin Turner, Valley County Sheriff's office; and Rich Webb, Smith's Ferry Groomer.

Mark Wood motioned that the minutes be approved as presented; seconded by Rob Workman. Motion carried.

USFS – Mark Wood reported that Emily Simpson, from the Payette Forest Service, was unable to attend, but requested that he inform everyone that on the Ordinance – if snow shoer's, cross country skiers, dog walkers, dog sledders, etc were include. The definition was that if they want to be on a groomed trail, they buy a sticker. Period. Can we add verbiage that if they purchase a registration sticker, they can be on the trail.

SHERIFF'S REPORT: Kevin Turner added that he was concerned about wording for release of liability in regards to a wheeled vehicle being removed. He also noticed that there are trailers that have been moved into Francis Wallace and are permanant for the winter. Suggestions to limit permanent parking in the parking lot. Three days for unattached trailed and up to 5-days to a week for attached. Another suggestion was to designate long term parking that is limited; no parking for long term anywhere else.

NEW BUSINESS

Road Ordinances: Review of the ordinance and suggestion for changes. It was asked that we add to 5-5-2: Restrictions, #3. Lights: Without a lighted headlight and taillight and/or strobe.

Change 5-5-2: Restrictions #5. Valid Registrations: Without current valid registration (certificate of Number) with the user and current certificate of number with the user.

5-5-1: Definitions – SNOWMOBILE: Add to end "may be permitted by commissioners".

5-5-3: Closed Public Roadways: C. Add- the unplowed areas of Brush Creek and East Lake Drive to the trailheads.

5-5-3: Closed Public Roadways: D:4. Add- Minimum \$400 plus fines.

5-7-3: Penalties: Add- Each trail user must possess and display a current certificate of number.

Trailhead Updates: Mark Wood discussed the Stop Signs that can be purchased. Discussion took place regarding wording and number of signs needed.

OLD BUSINESS

Staff, Hiring, Training Update: John Hicks updated everyone that they have hired and have held training. It went exceptionally well.

Mark Wood purchased an airport type blade at auction. He had brackets made to be able to attach it to a loader or backhoe. If it works well at Francis Wallace, the blade will be available for the program to purchase, if wanted, at cost.

Larry Meredith motioned that the meeting be adjourned; seconded by Terri Klanderud. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
