DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR YOUR INTERVIEW

Please bring the following information with you to your scheduled interview:

1. Proof of identity, such as your driver's license or photo identification card.
2. Social Security number or immigration card.
3. Copies of your lease or rental agreement for the dwelling where you live.
4. Proof of all household income from ALL sources for the last six (6) months, including all adult members of your household:

Wage stubs
Veteran benefits
Child support

Employer earning statements
Social Security / SSI
Alimony

Settlements / Stocks
Unemployment
Retirement / Trusts

5. The last six (6) months of bank statements including checking, savings, escrow and credit union accounts for all adult members of your household.
6. If self-employed, the year-to-date bookkeeping records including sales and expense records and 1099's.
7. A complete copy of the most recent federal and state income tax returns with schedules and W-2's
8. Proof of filed application or documents from agency showing current benefit amount or eligibility, including but not limited to:

Unemployment benefits
Medicare / Medicaid
AABD (Aid for Aged, Blind and Disabled)

Worker's compensation
Food stamps
TAFI (Temporary Assistance for Families in Idaho)
Housing / Rental / Energy assistance

Social security
Crime Victim's
TAFI (Temporary Assistance for Families in Idaho)

9. Proof of monthly expenses (including balances / arrears owed) for all adult members of your household, including:

Current month's rent
Child support
Auto insurance
Utility bills

Land / House payment
Child care
All other insurance
Auto payments

Space rent
Medical expenses
Alimony
Other monthly expenses

10. Any other pertinent documents that pertain to your situation.

NOTE: Your name or spouse's name must appear on the statements / bills
