- 1. Read and sign the Community Service Agreement form and return to the Community Service Coordinator. This will be your proof you have checked in for Community Service.
- 2. Community Service <u>MUST</u> be performed at a **Non-Profit Organization operating under a 501(c)(3) or Government Agency.** The attached list is of qualified agencies in Valley, Ada and Canyon Counties.
- 3. Online Community Service will not be accepted.
- **4.** You will need to complete a **minimum** of 10 hours of service per month.
- 5. Take your Time Sheet with you each time you perform your Community Service and have the site supervisor sign off on it before leaving each day.
- **6.** Time sheets must have legible contact information including, phone number, so that the hours can be verified.
- 7. Completed Time Sheets must be submitted to the Community Service Coordinator at Valley County Court Services.
